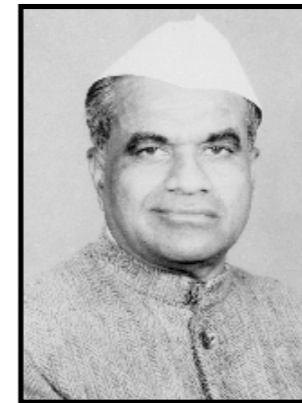

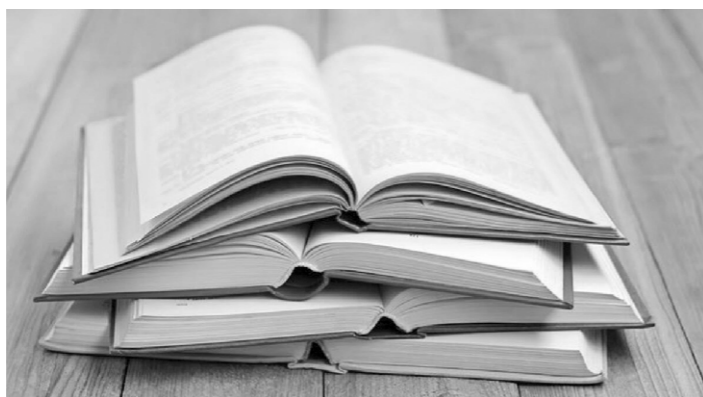


THOUGHTS ON EDUCATION
